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## SPECIAL LECTURE ON AZERBAIJANI HISTORICAL, CULTURAL, AND MUSLIM HERITAGE BY DR. RAFIG RUSTAMOV

In collaboration with the Embassy of Azerbaijan in Malaysia, Angkatan Belia Islam Malaysia (ABIM) and UM UNESCO Club, a special lecture entitled "Azerbaijani Historical, Cultural, and Muslim Heritage" was held on the 29th June 2022.

The program began with welcome remarks from the UMCCD Director. This was followed by a special address by the Guest of Honour, His Excellency Irfan Davudov, Ambassador of the Republic of Azerbaijan to Malaysia. Assoc. Prof. Dr. Durriyyah Sharifah Hasan Adli was the moderator. The special lecture was delivered by Dr. Rafig Rustamov, Counselor/Deputy Head of Mission, Embassy of Azerbaijan in Malaysia. The lecture focused on the military occupation of Azerbaijan by Armenia - its socio-economic consequences, the damages on religious-cultural monuments, and the life changes experienced by the people of Azerbaijan after the occupation. Cooperation between UNESCO and the authorities in Azerbaijan, before and after the occupation was also mentioned. The lecture highlighted the importance of dialogue among civilisations and its significance in the history of human culture and international relations. At the end of the program, Mr. Muhammad Faisal Abdul Aziz, President of ABIM, delivered the closing remarks.

# ICONCIDI'22 INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON CIVILISATIONAL DIALOGUE 2022



The International Conference on Civilisational Dialogue 2022 (ICONCIDI '22) took place from 17 to 18 August 2022 via Zoom platform. The conference was organised around six sessions with six sub-themes over the two days. UMCCD Director welcomed delegates and introduced the conference theme "The Future of Civilisation: Reimagining Sustainability". The main objective of the two-day event was to explore issues on sub-themes which included: Future of Civilisations & Dialogue of Civilisations (DoC); Circular Economy & Climate Justice; Science, Religion & Worldviews; Sustainable Development & Local Actions; Social Justice & Widening Gaps between the Rich and Poor; and The Meaning of Being Human in the Era of Al.

She highlighted the importance of peaceful coexistence and referred to UMCCD as a centre that encourages DoC for peace. The first keynote speaker, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Ellisha Nasruddin, Graduate School of Business, Universiti Sains Malaysia (USM), presented her paper entitled "Civilisations and Dialogue of Civilisations (DoC): Anticipation and Transformative Futures". Dr. Ellisha focused on the context of "Futures of Learning", with regards to civilisations and DoC. Moderated by the UMCCD Director, **Session 1** also included presentations from Assoc. Prof. Dr. Vishalache Balakrishnan and Dr. Alwani Ghazali. Dr. Vishalache shared basic concepts about authentic dialogue, its characteristics, and the attributes of educators who practice authentic dialogue. Dr. Alwani's presentation entitled "Epistemological Challenges Of Interreligious Dialogue", explained about the challenges confronted by practitioners of interreligious dialogue from both liberals and conservatives. The conference was continued with an enlightening talk by Assoc. Prof. Dr. Dzuljastri Abdul Razak, Associate Professor, Kulliyyah of Economics and Management Sciences, IIUM Gombak Campus for **Session 2**. Dr. Dzuljastri shared issues related to circular economy & climate justice. Moderated by Assoc. Prof. Dr. Wendy Yee Mei Tien, the third plenary session

featured Prof. Dr. Ibrahim Mohamed Zein, Professor of Islamic Studies and Comparative Religion from College of Islamic Studies, Hamad Bin Khalifa University (HBKU), Qatar. Prof. Ibrahim's keynote was entitled "Al-Biruni & The Scientific Investigation of Calendars: Worldviews and Religions". He delved into the different types of calendars and their applications. The first presenter for **Session 3** was Mr. Mohammad Mustaqim Malek, who presented on "Ethics in Animals Experimentation: The Concept of Al-Darūrah as A Complementary to the Principles of 3Rs". In a presentation entitled "Issues of Interfaith Dialogue Implementation in Malaysia", the second presenter, Mr. Ahmad Mohamad, talked about criticisms faced by interreligious dialogue and its implementation.

Moderated by Assoc. Prof. Dr. Chai Lay Ching, the second day of the conference started with a keynote presentation by Dr. Sharina Abdul Halim, Deputy Director, Institute for Environment and Development (LESTARI), UKM, entitled "Sustainable Development & Local Actions". Dr. Sharina started her speech by referring to the book "The Rural Development Putting the Last First" as well as Kofi Annan's comment that the biggest challenge in this century is to take sustainable development into daily reality. Session 4 also featured Ms. Farah Idayu Ruslan, Ms. Previari Umi Pramesti, Dr. Suzana Ariff Azizan and Zohaib Hassan Sain. Session 5 keynote speaker was Prof. Datuk Dr. Osman Bakar, Emeritus Professor of Philosophy of Science, Universiti Malaya & Al-Ghazali Chair of Epistemology and Civilizational Studies and Renewal, ISTAC-IIUM. The moderator was Assoc. Prof. Dr. Vishalache Balakrishnan. His plenary keynote address was on "Social Justice & Widening Gaps Between the Rich and Poor". Prof Osman mentioned that among the consequences of social injustice is rampant poverty and great disparity in wealth between the rich and poor. Presenters for this session were Mrs. Suhaila Mohamad and Dr. Siti Hafsyah Idris. Finally, moderated by Mr. Collins, Prof. Dr. Anantha Duraiappah, Director of the UNESCO Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Education for Peace and Sustainable Development, was introduced in his presentation entitled "The Meaning of Being Human in the Era of Al". Anantha made pertinent observations regarding being truly humans in the AI era today. Prof. Azizan Baharuddin closed the conference by thanking the delegates and presenters for their participation. The excellent teamwork of UMCCD members and organising committee was also acknowledged.

As stated in the National Unity Policy, under the concept of unity, "social cohesion" is a concept that describes the experience of our multi-racial and multi-ethnic Malaysians, living in peace, stability and harmony. However, challenges in achieving unity known as social deficits have been raised by Malaysians. On 26th October 2022, a focus group discussion (FGD) involving 15 experts from the education, government, and non-government sectors was held. The title of the FGD was "Peranan sistem pendidikan dalam memupuk perpaduan", focusing on the social deficit of education. The FGD was moderated by Prof. Zulkifli A. Manaf, former professor in Education at UM and UniSZA. The participants were enthusiastic in discussing the role of education towards unity. Some participants claimed that instead of acting as a unifying factor, our education system may have failed to unite us. Some participants highlighted the efforts done by the government in nurturing social unity among the people, but admit that improvements still need to be done in terms of the monitoring and implementation of the current strategies. Based on the facts and findings presented during the FGD, a policy brief was written.

On the 22nd November 2022, together with the Institut Masa Depan Malaysia (MASA), another focus group discussion (FGD) involving 15 experts from the education, government, and nongovernment sectors was held. This FGD focused on the social deficit of "ethnicity". The title of the FGD was "Penasionalisasian dialog kearah perpaduan dalm konteks kepelbagaian etnik". The FGD started with a discussion on the factors that might be the root causes of the social deficit based on ethnicity. One of the participants stated that the lack of understanding between different ethnic groups and also the lack of willingness in our people to learn about the culture of other ethnic groups are some of the reasons for this situation. Besides that, the geographical and economical distribution of Malaysians also contribute to this issue. The role of dialogue in nurturing social unity among Malaysians and other strategies that seem possible in encouraging interactions between different ethnic groups were also discussed. A policy brief was also written based on the inputs gathered.






