VISA APPLICATION

FOR NEW INTERNATIONAL STUDENT DURING THE PANDAMIC COVID-19

Since new international students are not allowed to physically enter the country, no **Electronic Visa Approval Letter (eVAL)** will be issued by the Malaysian Immigration Department from now until further notice.

However, new students are required to **submit application for eVAL** and this can be done at the Education Malaysia Global Services (EMGS) website at https://educationmalaysia.gov.my after receiving the offer letter from UM (a processing fee will be charged upon submission of the eVAL). Latest guideline and updates on the eVAL application is available at https://educationmalaysia.gov.my/visa-new-application/.

Students are advised to monitor the progress of eVAL application. Once it reaches 32% (IM14U – Document ready for submission to Immigration), EMGS will issue an Approval Letter and students need to upload the letter to MAYA portal before starting online registration on 5th October 2020.

Students will not be allowed to register at MAYA portal until the EMGS Approval Letter is uploaded. Please note that NO PHYSICAL ENTRY to Malaysia is allowed at this point in time. This means students are to remain in their country of origin until further notice and register from home country.
