Changing role of University

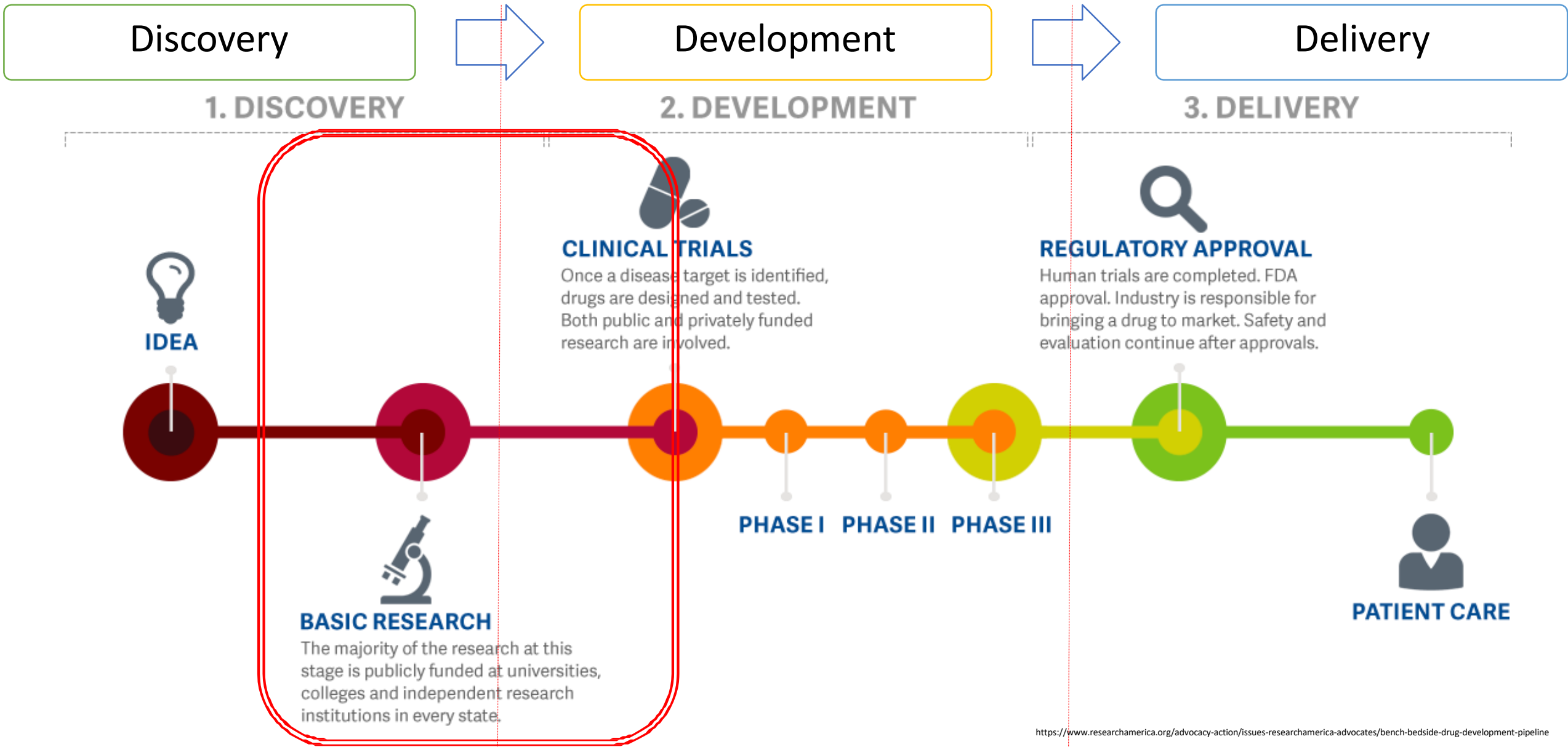
social responsibility and transfer of knowledge - **relevant** to society, **anticipate** what are society’s needs - **IMPACTFUL**
