
UMCORG 2025

Universiti Malaya aspires to be a major global player in doing **innovative and impactful research**. Hence, the establishment of Centre of Research (CoR) is to promote world class research particularly in interdisciplinary, multidisciplinary and trans-disciplinary areas.

In line with the university's aspirations, the Universiti Malaya Centre of Research Grant (UMCoRG) 2025 aims to foster the **sustainability of research excellence** that supports the university's research strategies.



OBJECTIVES





THEMES OF RESEARCH

Each proposed research project must be based on the respective niche area of the CoR, which also support the ten (10) strategic thrust areas of UM:

- 1. Nuclear energy and new energy transition
- 2. Food sustainability and security
- 3. Semiconductor and chips
- 4. Nanotechnology and quantum exploration
- 5. Artificial Intelligence and digital robotic realms
- 6. Space science and new engineering spectrum
- 7. Defense and security assets and inventory innovation and creation
- 8. Rare earths and critical minerals
- 9. Comprehensive medical and health spectrum excellence
- 10. Social Science Advancement in Economic, Smart Finance, Societal, International Norms and Law, and Geopolitical Spectrum for the Nation and the World



TERMS & CONDITIONS

General

- Open to all CoR with official establishment documents at the level of JKPU / Senate / LPU & meet the basic criteria – minimum of 5 Core Members.
- Proposed research project based on the specific niche area of the CoR and align with the 10 strategic thrust areas of UM.
- Proposed research project is a:
 - i. New research project (never been funded),or
 - ii. Project which is currently receiving funding from other internal or external grants, **or**
 - iii. Continuation / expansion of the past research project.
- Only 1 application per CoR.
- Eligible categories of CoR Top Down, Central, Faculty.
- CoR that already secured UMCoRG 2024 is not eligible to apply.

Grant Ceiling

RM100,000.00

- i. Phase 1: RM 50,000.00
- ii. Phase 2: RM 50,000.00

Note:

- i. Phase 2 funding will be disbursed after Phase 1 output targets is achieved.
- ii. Maximum period to achieve Phase 1 output targets:
 - a) Maximum 18 months for a 24-month project.
 - b) Maximum 24 months for a 36-month project.

Duration

24 months OR 36 months

Extension:

1 time with a maximum period of 6 months only.

Collaboration

Researchers must collaborate with at least 1 international institution / organization or industry.

In addition, researchers are encouraged to collaborate with higher education institutions, government agencies or non-governmental organizations at the national level.



TERMS & CONDITIONS

Principal Investigation (PI)

- An academic staff & a core member of a CoR with a permanent or contract status:
 - a) Associate Professor,
 - b) Senior Lecturer, or
 - c) Lecturer
- Permanent staff minimum duration of 3 years before the date of retirement.
- Contract staff a remaining minimum appointment period of 2 years.
- PI should not has any internal or external active grant.

Next Appointed Leader (NAL)

- An academic staff & a core member of the same CoR as per the PI with a permanent or contract status:
 - a) Associate Professor,
 - b) Senior Lecturer, or
 - c) Lecturer
- Permanent staff minimum duration of 3 years before the date of retirement.
- Contract staff a remaining minimum appointment period of 2 years.

Co-Researcher(s)

- Academic staff(s) (core member) of the CoR:
 - a) Professor,
 - b) Associate Professor, or
 - c) Senior Lecturer,
- Staff of the CoR is allowed to involve in the project:
 - a) Research Officer / Science Officer
- The Head of CoR must be coresearcher and involved in the project.
- The project research team must consist at least of five (5) core members of the CoR.
- At least 1 permanent academic staff as a co-researcher.
- Define each roles in the project.



OUTPUTS

All outputs are compulsory to be fulfilled within the project period

Phase 1

- i. Science & Technology **2** Q1 / Q2 Web of Science-indexed publications.
- ii. Social Sciences, Arts and Humanities **2** Q1 / Q2 Scopus-indexed publications.


Phase 2

- i. Science & Technology **2** Q1/Q2 Web of Science-indexed publications.
- ii. Social Sciences, Arts and Humanities **2** Q1 / Q2 Scopus-indexed publications.

*Note: Produce at least 2 joint publications with international / industry collaborator(s)

1 Postgraduate student

*Note: Postgraduate student produced not necessary to be appointed as RA / GRA for this project. If the application is successful, please provide an offer letter as a postgraduate student who is working on this project and enclose it together with the progress report.



3 categories:

- i. At least **1** MoA / LoA / Research Agreement.
- ii. At least **1** other output e.g. product/ policy/ module/ book/ chapter in book(s)/ Intellectual Property (IP), etc.
- iii. At least **1** activity (physical / online) for knowledge sharing e.g. seminar/ workshop/ webinar, etc.

IMPORTANT

The project outputs are the **shared** responsibility of all researchers listed in the submitted proposal.



HIGHLIGHTS

- 1. Announcement call for proposal is on 14.01.2025 via UMinfo. All related documents for your reference can be downloaded from Ms. 365 SharePoint at the following link: (Documents: CLICK HERE).
- 2. **IMPORTANT:** Please read the guidelines carefully. Pay close attention to crucial information e.g. terms & conditions, eligibility, specific type of expenses permitted / not permitted, required documentation, application deadline etc. **Incomplete and / or late applications can result in immediate disqualification.**
- 3. Budget Please plan the budget for each vote wisely and provide specific details / breakdown / justification e.g. details of fieldwork activities (location, transportation use, number of days, number of people involve, etc.); list of research material & supplies etc.

4. Allocation

- a) Vote 11000 to employ / pay **GRA or RA**. However, Postgraduate student produced not necessary to be appointed as RA / GRA for this project. (Refer to note page 7)
- b) Vote 21000 **covers** travel for fieldwork / conference / training.
- c) Vote 27000 **only research-related** expenses are **allowed**. Purchases of stationery supplies, electronic devices and other ICT equipment, e.g. laptop / desktop / printer / external hard disk / etc., are **not permitted**.
- d) Vote 29000 **not cover proofreading** service; **can allocate** up to a maximum of total RM20,000.00 (RM10,000 each phase) per project **for the page charge** & researchers are **encouraged** to apply for the **JPP Page Charge Fund** (<u>UM Research Website</u>).






*Post-award

- **1. Re-allocation / virement** maximum 20% from the total approved for the vote.
- 2. Acknowledgement of Research Output must acknowledge UMCoRG as the primary source of funding. A maximum of three (3) grants are allowed to be acknowledged and UMCoRG must be the first grant in the sequence of acknowledgment. Only outputs produced after the grant has been awarded and directly resulting from the research work under this grant will be accepted.
