Description:

The objective of this activity is to strengthen the relationship between all the senior citizens and to bring the happiness to the senior citizens. This activity also taught importance of caring to senior citizens in the society. Furthermore, this activity also to ensure the cleanliness of the senior citizens house with the help of the SPAS students.

The first event was sharing session with the senior citizens. This event starts at 9.30 am after the leader meet and greet the person who incharged the house and introduce herself to the senior citizens. All students took part in this activity where they introduce themselves to the senior citizens. We started to ask about their life and about their condition because many of them were sick and cannot walk. They were so excited in sharing and have a chat with us. We also gave them 100 packs of taufufah where that is their favourite.

After the sharing session, 8 international students from China and 2 local Chinese students makes a performance to entertain the senior citizens. They sang a China song which can be understood by the senior citizens because many of them only understand in Cantonese and Mandarin language. Some of them were not able to understand and communicate with Malay and English language. So, only the international students and Chinese students took part in the singing performance while other student sit beside the senior citizens to entertain them. They were so enjoyed with the performance and some of them were singing along with the students.

After that, we cleaning the senior citizens house. There are five groups for cleaning which are sweeping, mopping, cleaning outside the house, wiping the window and mosquito net and have a chat with the senior citizens. For all this activity, the nurse has provided us with brooms, mops and pail. We only prepared the garbage plastics and wiper cloth. The sweeping and mopping were

done in the house by 7 students. The other groups for wiping the window and mosquito net were handled by 5 students. 4 students were cleaning the outside area where they removed the grass by using glove. This is to ensure the outside area were clean and not messy with the long grass. All the rubbish and the grass were thrown in the garbage plastics provided. The other students were having a chat with the senior citizens while helping the others in cleaning. When the cleaning activity were settled, we get together in the house with the senior citizens for closing session. The activity then ended with a plaque and certificates giving session.

For this activity, we want to thank to the owner of True Happiness Elderly Care as well as the person incharge for the house and the nurses for engaging and help us in planning and carry out the event successfully. We would also want to thank all the senior citizens in the house for gave us the opportunity to engage with them.

We do what we can to these old people. They cleaned the house and sang songs to them. I felt very happy with them.

Description:

The objective of this activity is to expose new vocabulary to the children. This activity also can boost their confidence to speak in English. Other than that, the children can enhance their speaking skills with our guidance.

The first activity was the ice breaking game which is called the “rusty telephone”. Firstly, the children and SPAS students were divided into 3 groups. In each group, we assigned 2 of spas students to be the leader of the group. We have prepared a piece of paper for each group that consists of a long tongue twister phrase. When the first person received the paper, they have to quietly memorize the phrase for 2 minutes. When the time is up, the person will whisper the phrase that they have memorize to the next person and the next person will have to memorize it too for 2 minutes without looking at the original paper. This continues until the last person memorized it. So, when all groups were done, we called out the last person to the front and each of them have to say whatever words that they can memorize. Only one group were succeeded to memorize each and every word correctly. In a nutshell, they had fun and were excited to play the next activity.

The second activity was Pictionary. We have prepared 8 cards filled with one word for each group. The leader of the group will be given the cards, a piece of blank paper and a pencil. In this game, whoever gets the card, they have to draw it in the blank paper given and the other group members has to guess what is the word. Each group will be given 2 minutes to guess. Description:

The objective of this activity is to expose students with university lifestyle. This programme also wants to encourage students to further their studies as we know that form 5 participants would finish their school this year. In this programme, there are five games. The main objective if these games are to improve their confidence level, critical thinking and creativity.

The first thing that we do is ice breaking. We divide the students into 6 groups. Each of the groups at least has 10 students and each of groups has 3 students from SPAS as their facilitator. For the first activity, we asked them to create their group's name and cheer so they can discuss and at the same time it creates bonding among them.

Next, focus game. For this game, each group will get one sentence. Then, all of them will lines up. The last person will memorize the words (1 min only), then they will pass the words. The last person that received the words will gather at the stage and need to tell the words. We have 2 rounds for this game. The first round is easier than the second round. Duration for these games is 30 minutes. There is one group that manage to get all the words correctly.

Our second game is critical thinking. Each group will get 9 plates and 4 skewers. The plates represent the dots and skewers will represent the lines. They only can use 4 lines to connect all nine dots. Duration for this game is 10 minutes. There is one group manage to get the answer as soon the game started because one of their members have played this game. This game is done less than 10 minutes and because of that, we teach them a cheer.

The third game is teamwork. We give them ropes. They need to tie the ropes at their waist and need to put the pencil in the middle. They must put the pencil in the bottle and only the leader can give instruction. This game took about 30 minutes. This game also has 2 rounds which first round is easier than the second round. For the first round, we just put the bottle nearby with their group but the second round, we put the bottle further away from them and all the members need to close their eyes except the leader.

At 10.30am until 10.50am, we had a break. We gave them bread and water for their break. At 11 am, all students were gathering back at the hall.

For the last game, it involved creativity and time management. All of them need to create a building as tall as they can, have function and stable by using newspaper. Before starting, we gave each team 2 minutes to discuss what building they want to create. After that, this game will start with the leader first. Leader only has 1 minute to create the building (all teammates just watch). After 1 minute, other members can continue making the building except for the leader. The leader can give instruction. Duration time for this game is 15 minutes. After 15 minutes, each group leader brings their building to the in front and explains about their building.

As a conclusion to the games we called one person from each of the group to explain what all these activities. Next, after play all the games, we had a sharing session from Nur Farhana bt Mat Roze, Ng Jia Shin, Syahirah Syafina bt Shafee, Loveline Ubung Martin and Safina Jihan Amani. All of them have a different path before entering the University of Malaya. Farhana took a diploma, Jia Shin took STPM, Syahirah entering matriculation, love entering asasi and Safina is an international student. Their share their experience, pro and cons. The purpose of this sharing session is to help the students to choose what path they want after SPM.

Lastly, we SPAS student do the performance which is Merdeka dance. All the students follow our steps and they seem to enjoy. Before we released the students, we give the present for 3 winners which are group 3, group 2 and group 6.

Description:

First and foremost, one of the aims to conduct this activity is to lead a healthy lifestyle among SPAS students as well as the community of Kampung Gajah by exercising hand and eye coordination with the focus of participants. In the gotong-royong program, SPAS students are expected to have a sense of responsibility towards a clean environment. Besides strengthening the bond between the community of Kampung Gajah and SPAS students, healthy competitions can be fostered among them. It is important to achieve the value of teamwork and cooperation in order to make this event a success.

From homestay to Laman Baroh, Bendang Besar in Kampung Gajah, we took around 15 minutes for preparation. We arrived at the destination safely at around 3.15pm. The villagers were already waiting for us and gave us a warm welcome when we reached. According to the briefing from the president of Village Community Management Council (MPKK), Encik Kamil Bin Sidon, we had separated into 3 groups. The first group consisted of all boys where they were responsible for outdoor cleaning. For the other two groups, it consisted of girls where they would be going to cleaning surau. For me and other four committee members, we were waiting for youth and sports officer, Encik Payrol for his arrival and arrangements. It took around an hour for gotong-royong from 3.30pm to 4.30pm and all SPAS students were treated a tea break. At the same time, we had got ready for the props in that selected area. Thanks to Encik Payrol bin Makasuf and his team for their assistance.

The first game was started at around 4.45pm with 'Bursting balloon'. In this telematch, five groups consisting of SPAS students and villagers joined. For each group, it consisted of 4 members. The first member from each group had to run to opposite to blow the balloon until it burst, then ran back to his or her original position. The second member continued the game after coming back of the first member. The game began after making crystal clear instructions to the participants. The winner was the group that completing the tasks with the fastest speed. The name of the winner's representative was recorded for the purpose of prize giving ceremony.

Next, the second game was named 'Spoon with Ping Pong Ball'. This game was constructed to test the balancing and focusing of participants. There were five groups in total, each with 7 members. We really felt like it was a huge deal to have an activity involving big organisations. We were able to see how they too engaged with the villagers.

Another achievement was through the Cultural Night on the third day. We were able to show the villagers of Kampung Gajah performances from different cultures. For example, the Saman dance lead by our Indonesian students, Safina Jihan Amani and Darin Mikaila and the Sumazau dance lead by Scholastika Juis. The students from China also performed two Chinese songs. The villagers who came were amazed by our performances. We were also stunned when watching a performance by the Marhaban group of Kampung Gajah due to their spirit and energy. It was sort of an exchange of talents during that night and it was indeed a night to remember.

Lastly, the Kampung Gajah Sports Day, everyone had gain the awareness of importance in exercise in order to keep a healthy lifestyle and also the importance of teamwork when working as a team. We were able to create a strong bond with the villagers of Kampung Gajah through this activity because everyone from different ages and background were involved. The Tok Sidang even let us plant a few coconut trees as a token of appreciation and memories for us to come and visit Kampung Gajah again in the future.
