9 February 2021 - Professor Dato' Ir. Dr. Mohd Hamdi Abd Shukor conducted a live Zoom webinar presenting the Universiti Malaya (UM) Strategic Plan for 2021 – 2025 to the campus community, in conjunction with his first 100 days as UM Vice Chancellor.

He shared our vision of becoming a global university impacting the world and our mission to push the boundaries of knowledge and nurture aspiring leaders. The focus is on UM's five (5) Pillars of Organisational Excellence – Income Generation, Teaching & Learning, Research & Innovations, Talent and Entrepreneurship. He also encouraged UM to embrace our core values of Passion, Oneness, Integrity, Sincerity and Empathy (POISE).

UM is the educational flag bearer of Malaysia with the QS World University Rankings recently has listed UM as No. 59 university in

the world and the only OIC (Organisation of Islamic Cooperation) member country – out of 57 – to be in the top 100 of the QS World University Rankings as of 2021. UM aspires to fulfil its fullest potential through leveraging on untapped strengths, talents, research and future leaders. In spite of Covid-19 disruptions changing the way of doing things, UM is intended to continue to make the nation proud.

To transform dreams into reality, UM has established a Project Management Office (PMO) to oversee the transformation journey which includes UM Strategic Plan, UM Transformation Plan and UM Health Initiatives. UM aims to move towards a self-sustaining university that produces future leaders for the nation. UM will become a dynamic learning organisation and a centre of excellence for knowledge and research solutions.

23 March 2021 - Professor Dr. Noorsaadah binti Abdul Rahman, Deputy Vice Chancellor (Research & Innovation) presented the Universiti Malaya Townhall Strategic Plan 2021 - to 2025 House of Excellence Pillar 3: Research & Innovations on live streaming.

Research & Innovation is one of the five pillars supporting UM's mission organisational excellence; to address the decline in the intake of postgraduate students by research over the years, four (4) new initiatives will be implemented -Research Fund Opportunities, Publication Rewards, Research Ecosystem and UM Scholarship Programme.


Research Fund Opportunities – Granting 50% of student fees to supervisors to use as starting research funds (currently applies only to new PhD recruits starting September 2021) and formulating a matching fund for industrial and international grants (RM1 given to UM for every RM3 grant). Other initiatives include developing a platform/database of funders and calls for proposals, planning meetings with stakeholders and creating system records for copyrighting top-drawer proposals.

WoS Publication Rewards - Allocating rewards earned from published papers as a top-up grant based on the indexing category - Science, Social Sciences and Arts & Humanities. The reward goes to the principal investigator (PI) who (if the paper is a team effort) assigns the necessary amount to UM co-authors. Currently, the total allocation is RM3mil with a maximum of RM15,000 (cumulative) per researcher per year.

Research Ecosystem - Creating a Research Impact Strategic Unit to enhance publication quality and citations, transform publications into books, increase citations to improve academic impact and push UM's journal into the WoS and Scopus index. This also includes Researcher **Empowerment** to improve research communication and negotiation and impact beyond academia.

UM Scholarship Program - Introducing competitive scholarship program for PhD aimed towards highly qualified recruits in September 2021. This program provides full (100 students, RM4.5mil allocated) and partial (200 students. RM3mil allocated) scholarships with 3 years maximum duration.

MALAYSIA TECHNOLOGY EXPO MTE 2021 AWARD WINNERS





22-26 March 2021 - UM has won 2 Special Awards, 3 Gold and 5 Silver Awards at the Malaysia Technology Expo (MTE) 2021 held virtually this year.

Malaysia Technology Expo (MTE) started off as a platform for innovators to showcase their findings in year 2021 and now it has grown to become one of the region's most recognised and respected international innovation exhibitions, each year connecting participants with industry players. In fact, MTE has built a culture of excellence, being known for its prestigious awards and continues to welcome over 500 exhibits annually. DIALOGUE PROGRAM ON HALAL VACCINE



14 January 2021 - UM Centre for Civilisational Dialogue (UMCCD) and Halal Research Centre (UMHRC) has organized a webinar "Dialogue Program on Halal Vaccine" on 14 January 2021 via Google Meet.

With the outbreak of COVID-19 and now the production of vaccines for COVID-19, the halal status of the vaccine becomes the main concerns especially for the Malay community in Malaysia. As such, with the role of UMHRC to offers services including halal research, coaching, and training related to halal as well as the function of UMCCD to promote global peace and sustainability of human civilization through dialogue, it is highly desirable for these two centers to co-organise the abovementioned webinar to channel knowledge and provide exposure to the community about vaccine use from the point of view of fiqh and its importance.







The dialogue program moderated by Dr. Zalina Zakaria (Head of UMHRC) has invited three (3) panels to discuss the topic related to the halal vaccine. The panels are: i) Tuan Haji Amrahi Buang (President for the Malaysian Pharmaceutical Society); ii) Assoc. Prof. Dr. Saadan Man (Head Department of Fiqh & Usul, Academy of Islamic Studies UM); and iii) Mr. Johari Abu Latiff (Assoc. Member of UMHRC).

Each panel that specializes in different areas related to vaccination has given their insightful views on the topic. Tuan Haji Amrahi Buang elaborated his knowledge on the vaccine itself whereas Assoc. Prof. Dr. Saadan Man who is from the Usul al-Fiqh background analyses the aspect of Islamic rulings on the issue. The take-home message of the webinar is an eye-opener: vaccination is a very essential need for the sake of respecting one's life and the lives of others who co-exist with them.

There are more than 85 participants from various agencies (universities schools, and industries) from local and international have participated actively in the webinar.
